Keeping Your Fiddle Happy

Daily:

- 1. Wash the pizza off your hands before you handle the fiddle.
- 2. Use rosin sparingly.
- 3. Don't touch the hair on the bow or the strings where you play.
- 4. When you're done practicing, loosen the hair in the bow.
- 5. Wipe your fiddle off with a dry rag before you put it away.
- 6. Place the case in a safe place where it won't be in the sun or next to the heat ...or get stepped or sat on!

Every 3 – 6 Months:

- 1. Change the strings
- 2. Check carefully for cracks or open seams.

When to call the "doctor"

If...

- 1. You notice a crack or a seam coming apart
- 2. There are any strange buzzes
- 3. The soundpost falls over... please do not try to set it up yourself.
- 4. The hair is shedding on your bow.
- 5. The screw on the bow does not work smoothly
- 6. The bridge is tipping and you don't know how to safely straighten it.
- 7. A peg won't turn...don't use pliers!
- 8. A peg won't hold
